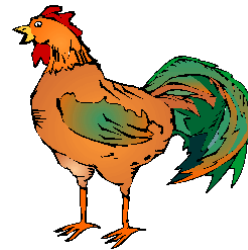


Animal Nuts & Crackers

so no work would get done.



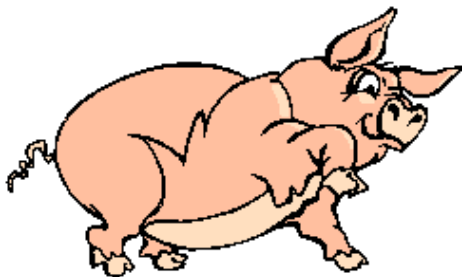
And what if the **Monkey** wanted to be a **Sheep**?

He might fall on you when he tried to fly.

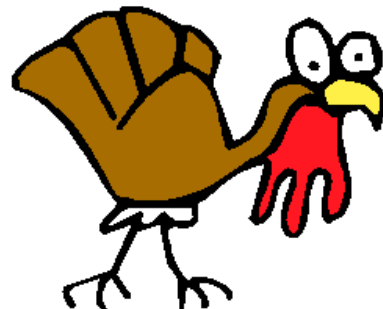
Or the **Mosquito** wanted to be a **Pig**?
