## Eating the Sun!

What do you think people would do if the sun totally disappeared in mid-day? Or if the full moon suddenly went dark? These events DO happen!! They're called eclipses, and they occur a few times every year someplace in the world.

The ancients thought of eclipses as omens, foretelling the future. The Chinese even believed that dragons in the sky were devouring the sun or the moon, and they made great noise to "scare" these demons away.






In reality, an eclipse is a specific precise alignment of the sun, Earth, and moon — all moving like clockwork in the universe which God created.

The fact that astronomers can predict exactly when eclipses will happen proves this point!

There are people today who follow old pagan beliefs — they think that the "energy" of the full moon can affect your life. The supposed "energy" varies in strength and power, depending on the phase. What utter nonsense!! The moon does not change just because we see it lit from different angles!

In the case of a solar eclipse (eclipse of the sun), the moon passes between the Earth and the sun, blocking the sun completely for a few minutes and casting a very narrow shadow onto the Earth.





During a lunar eclipse (eclipse of the moon), the moon slowly passes into the Earth's shadow and goes dark for a few hours.
