When speaking to your dog, use

you do this by looking straight at him. Never hit your dog —
he will assume you're being aggressive and he might fight
back. Your dog also depends on his

sense of smell – he can sniff out the slightest odour. That's why dogs (especially some breeds) are such good police dogs – they can find thieves and their loot.

A secret of communicating with your dog is to avoid talking too much!

He may think you've got problems and may start behaving oddly himself.



Did you know that smiling at a dog can cause him to think you are snarling at him and being aggressive?

It might be safer to avoid smiling at the dogs in your neighbourhood.
