

Who is God?

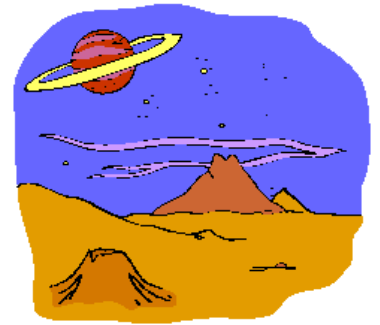


- ❖ God made the world and all the Universe.

Three Persons in One.

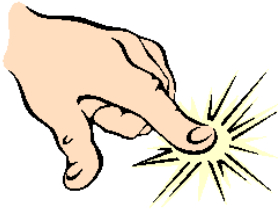


God the **Father** is Master over all creation

So too, God the Father, God the Son, and the Holy Spirit are parts of the one God.
