Who Will You Tell About Jesus?

Suppose a good friend from out of town is visiting you, and he or she wants to visit a place that you know isn't safe — but your friend doesn't know that.

Would you let your friend go and possibly get hurt?

Or would you suggest a better place to visit? If you'd suggest a better place, you're a real friend.

It's like that if you know about Jesus Christ as your Saviour. You're safe from danger, but maybe your friends aren't — because they don't know Jesus. No one has told them.

Jesus says we are to tell others about Him. That way, they'll know the way to heaven,

God's beautiful home. They can be safe from hell, which is a nasty neighbourhood. (Hell is only for people who don't believe in Jesus.)





How can you tell others about the Lord? You could say...

- Jesus is God's Son, and He's boss of the universe.
 - Jesus decides who goes to Heaven.
- He has that power because He never broke any of God's laws. All of us have sinned, but He has never sinned.
- ❖ If we admit we've sinned and ask Jesus to forgive us and save us. He does it — the moment we ask.
- Jesus will also help us every day of our lives.
- One day, all those who believe in Jesus will live with God in heaven — the greatest place imaginable!

Some people may never hear the message of Jesus – unless <u>you</u> tell them.

You can tell people at home, at school, in your neighbourhood, and in your city. You can tell friends on your teams, or in your clubs.

Prepare yourself to tell others by reading your Bible each day, and attending Sunday School, and by praying.

All these will help you to learn about God so you can explain these important truths to others.

Are you shy about telling others? Pray for courage.

If you tell someone and they make fun of you, don't take it personally.

Just pray for patience — and ask God to soften their heart

so they will want to hear the truth.
