Why Do Bad Things Happen?



- Shouldn't God stop people from killing?
- Shouldn't He protect children from harm?
- Why does God allow nice people to be hurt?

God understands our confusion. There are no easy answers.

But we can be sure that God can turn a bad situation
into something good.

The Bible tells us about a young fellow named Joseph. Joseph's brothers were jealous of him because their father loved him very much. The brothers wanted to get rid of Joseph, so they sold him to slave traders, who then took him to another country, Egypt. He had a rough time there, and he ended up in jail.



But God made an opportunity for Joseph. The leader of the country – Pharoah of

Egypt – learned that Joseph was wise and that he could tell people what their dreams meant. Pharoah had been having nightmares, so he asked Joseph what they meant.

Joseph revealed that the dreams meant a severe famine was coming to Egypt. He told Pharoah what to do so the people wouldn't starve but would have plenty of food.

Pharoah could see that Joseph was wise (Joseph got all his wisdom from the Lord). So he put Joseph in charge of the country, and everything worked out well.

Joseph became very powerful. Years later, even his brothers came to ask him to help them because they too were short of food. God allowed Joseph to save his whole family from starvation – including his father who had missed him very much and thought he was dead.

So, although his brothers had wanted to get rid of Joseph years ago, they were so grateful (and ashamed!) now that he was able to help them.

In fact, God used Joseph to bless many people.

"You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done, the saving of many lives." – Genesis 50:20

At the time that Joseph was having all his troubles, maybe he wondered why these things were happening to him. But he never complained. He always had faith in God.

Are you having a hard time right now? Has something bad happened to you or to your family? When these things happen, God wants you to have hope.
