

Learn from God's Creatures


Did you know that **God made the world**—all the mountains, oceans & lakes, plants, animals, and people?

Bears like to hibernate in winter.




They teach us to **rest in God's care**.

Elephants have a reputation for good memories. We too should recall that **God never forgets us** and **helps us always**.


For I am the LORD, your God,
