

Riding the Clouds




Look up at the sky.

Are there lots of clouds?

Did you know there are different kinds of clouds?

- ❖ Some look like huge puffy cotton balls – these are called **cumulus** clouds.
- ❖ Others form flattish layers that sweep across the sky – they're the **stratus** clouds.
 - ❖ **Cirrus** clouds often look like thinnish curls of smoke.
- ❖ **Nimbus** clouds are the rain clouds – heavy, dark, and foreboding.




If you've ever been in an airplane, high in the air, you've probably ridden above cirrus clouds – these are always very high up. It's a good thing the clouds don't just drop onto us... or we'd get awfully wet! All clouds are made up of water. When they're up high, the water is in the form of ice crystals. Lower clouds are usually made up of liquid water droplets.

God put a lot of thought into how He made the clouds.
He understands why they hold together so well and don't just fall apart.
God made them so interesting that we love to look at them!
Clouds are always changing and moving.
And they're so peaceful too – so soft and smushy
we feel we could just curl up into one.

God has an extra special job for His clouds. One day (we don't know when), the Lord Jesus will come back to gather all the people who believe in Him. And He will come riding the clouds!
Everyone will see Him.

And He'll take us to see His home in heaven. Jesus will raise all the dead who had put their faith in Him as their Saviour from sin. He'll give each person a wonderful new resurrection body that'll be just right for heaven.



And those believers who are still alive will also be lifted up to meet Him in the air – they too will receive perfect new bodies.

"For the Lord Himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever." – 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17
