

# What Can You Do For God?

Have you ever thought you were too young to serve God?

## *How does He do it?*

*Here are some of the ways you can serve the Lord  
after you become a child of God...*



1. If you're good at Math or Science or any other subject in school, you can **offer to help** someone who struggles with it.

2. You can **donate** a Christian story book  
(maybe a book of Bible stories)  
to your public library.



3. **Invite a friend to your church or Bible Club.**

4. **Pray** for your friends and their families – God is pleased  
to answer the prayers of His children.

5. Ask God to show you how to **help someone** – maybe by  
shovelling the driveway of an elderly neighbour, or offering to  
carry groceries  
for someone who is ill,  
or weeding a neighbour's yard.



6. **Forgive someone who has wronged you.**

7. **Tell a friend about Jesus Christ** and how He died  
and rose for them. Let them know that they can be  
a child of God just like you.

8. When you give a birthday gift, choose a Christian book or music CD, or maybe even a gift of your own artwork with one of your favourite *Bible verses* on it.



*9. Stand up for someone who is rejected just as Jesus has stood up for you.*

10. *Honour your body*, which is the holy temple of God, by staying away from drugs, alcohol, cigarettes, and other harmful things.

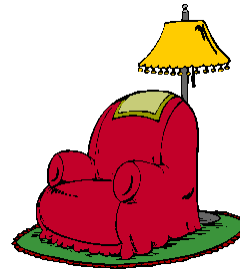


11. At the end of the school year, give your favourite teacher or coach a *thank-you card* with a nice message and a verse from Scripture.

*12. If you excel at sports, honour God as the giver of your skill - and show good sportsmanship.*

13. Pray that your *friends will know Jesus Christ* as their Lord and Saviour.

14. *Prepare yourself* to serve by attending church, reading your Bible each day, and praying - all these will help you to learn about God and what He'd like you to do.
