Revelation	What Heaven is like

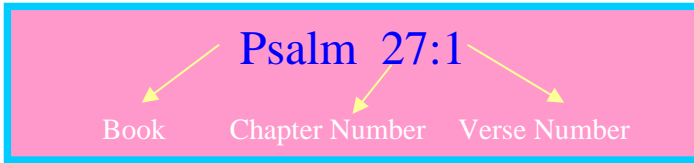
There are many books in the Bible... sixty-six in all. Be sure to read them all, because God has something special to teach you in each one.
